Program Description

The Psychiatric Security Review Board (PSRB) is a quasi-judicial agency with the task of protecting the public through reviewing the clinical and risk factors of individuals under its jurisdiction. Through full and administrative hearings conducted before the Board on an ongoing basis, appropriate placement for individuals is determined for either OSH or a Secure Adolescent In-Patient Program (SAIP) or alternately in the community on conditional release or discharge. Programs within PSRB oversight include:

- Guilty Except for Insanity (GEI),
- Responsible Except for Insanity (REI),
- Extremely Dangerous Persons with Mental Illness (PSRB Civil Commitment),
- Gun Relief, or
- Sex Offender Classification, Reclassification, and Relief.
