Request for List of Ballot Challenges

SEL 534

Unsigned Return Identification Ballot Envelope and Signature Does Not Match

A county elections official may disclose as a public record the name and residence address of a voter whose ballot is challenged because it is returned in an unsigned return identification ballot envelope or because the signature does not match the voter's registration record. The reason for challenge may also be disclosed.

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ORS 254.431 prohibits the disclosure of any information that could be used to identify these voters until the 15th day after an election.

In accordance with ORS 192.440 a county may establish fees reasonably calculated to reimburse the county for the actual cost of making a list of voters with ballots challenged because their ballot was returned in an unsigned return identification ballot envelope or because the signature does not match the voter's registration record available. These costs may include costs for summarizing, compiling or tailoring the public records, either in organization or media, to meet the person's request.
