Survey of Lodge Halls, Public Buildings

W. O. W. Hall

Approximately 30 x 40--2 stories--wide stairs--sanitary facilities on each floor--heat--water--kitchen facilities on first floor.

M. W. A. Hall

Approximately 32 x 46--2 stories--wide stairs--sanitary and kitchen facilities on first floor--heat--water.

K. P. Hall

Approximately 30 x 40 - first and second floors, each with sanitary facilities--stove heat--kitchen facilities on first floor--gas--rear and front entrances to first floor.

Masonic Hall

Third floor of building approximately 30 x 40 with cloak room and lobby. Hot water heat--sanitary facilities. Wide stairway. Fourth floor approximately 25 x 35--kitchen facilities--gas--heat.

Odd Fellow Hall

Second and third floors--approximately 50 x 75 , large room-club 25 x 30--stove heat--sanitary facilities. Third floor approximately 30 x 40--kitchen facilities--wood stove.

Commercial Club Rooms

Second floor--approximately 24 x 50--stove heat--high ceiling--kitchen facilities--gas--high narrow stairway.

Over Columbia Food Store

Second floor approximately 72 x 60--water--gas--stove heat--high ceiling--sanitary facility--high narrow stairway.

Silverton Armory

Fischer Brick Warehouse

Approximately 50 x 100--no sanitary facilities--owned by county.

Upper floor Dullum Building

Second floor approximately 40 x 60--water--no heat--one sanitary facility--very narrow high stairway.

Washington Irving School

Unused second floor rooms
