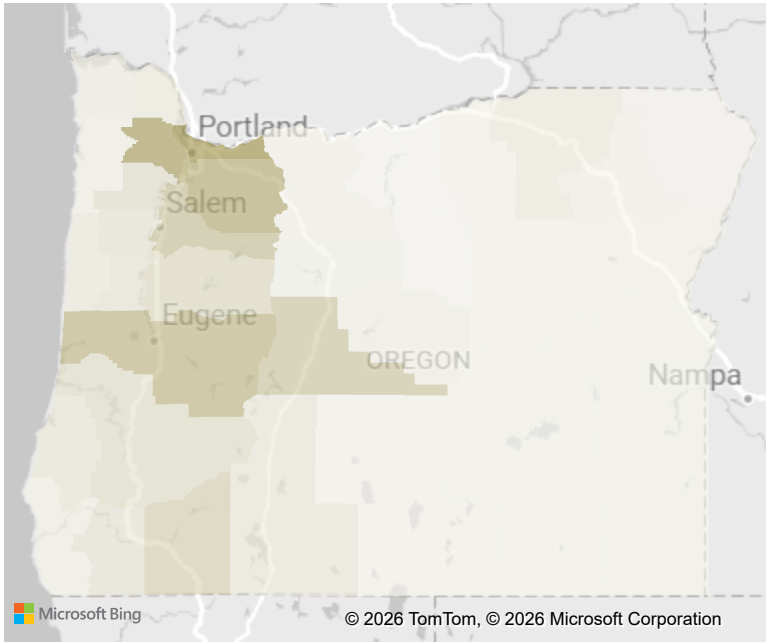

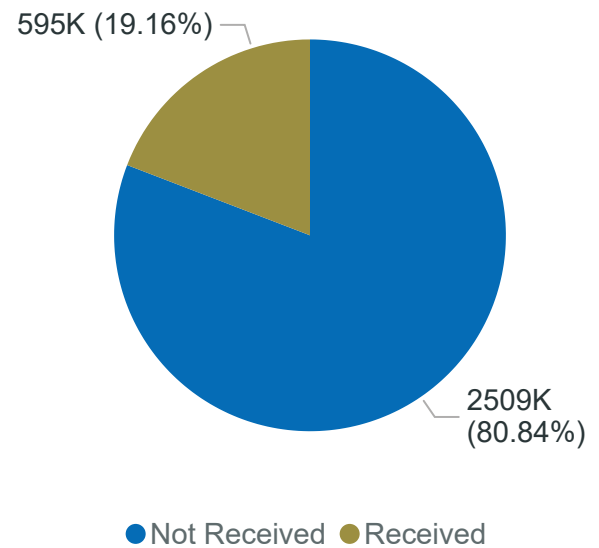

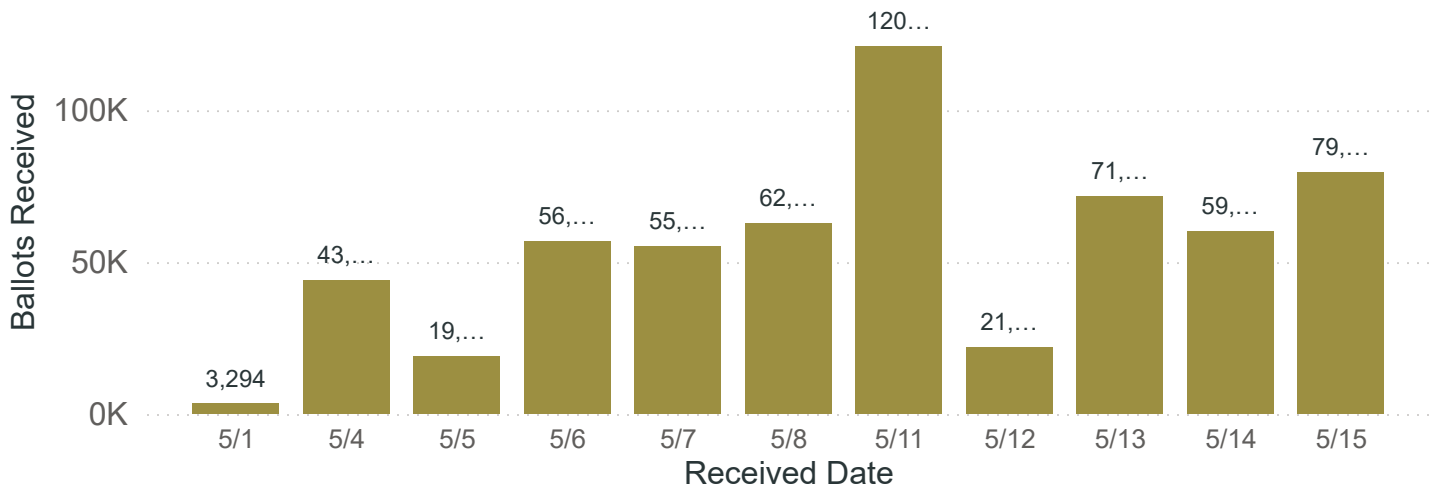

This report provides **raw, real-time data** on the number of ballot envelopes marked as returned in the Oregon Centralized Voter Registration (OCVR) and Election Management System during the election period.

The data in this report is **fluid**, meaning it changes as voter records are updated and as counties continue to receive and process ballots. Reports are generated from multiple data sources and reflect the most current information available at the time of publication.

It is important to note that **standard election administration practices require ballots to be recorded as “received” based on the date they are received**, not the date they are processed. This results in normal fluctuations in the daily return counts.
