**Initiative Referendum #402**

**“Amends Constitution: Eliminates slavery as a punishment for crime and allows a convicted person be ordered to engage in education, treatment or other alternatives to incarceration. Requires voter approval.”**

**Draft Estimate of Financial Impact:**

**Original:**

This measure will have no financial effect on either state or local government expenditures or revenues.

**Option A:**

The measure removes language allowing slavery and involuntary servitude as a punishment for a crime. The financial impact to state and local expenditures and revenues is indeterminate. The measure does not require additional state government revenues or expenditures however the impact of the measure will depend on potential legal action or changes to inmate work programs.
