



Registering to Vote in Oregon.

Your first step to making your voice heard.



Registering to vote in Oregon is quick, convenient, and essential to participating in our state's elections. Here's what you need to know to get started.

Q: Who can register to vote in Oregon?

A: To register to vote in Oregon, you must be:

- A U.S. citizen.
- A resident of Oregon.
- At least 16 years old (you must be 18 years old by Election Day to vote).

Q: Where can I register to vote?

A: You can register to vote:

- **Online:** Visit OregonVotes.gov to access the online registration for and step-by-step instructions.
- **By Mail:** Complete, sign, and mail in a paper voter registration card. Visit OregonVotes.gov for more information.
- **At the DMV:** You may be automatically registered to vote if you are found eligible during a transaction at the Oregon Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division (DMV).

Q: What do you need to register to vote?

A: To register to vote, you will need your signature and:

- An Oregon driver license, permit or ID card number issued by the DMV.
OR
- The last four digits of your social security number.

No Oregon driver license, permit, or ID card? Don't know the last four digits of your social security number? You can submit your voter registration card with the following acceptable forms of identification:

Q: When do I need to register to vote by?

A: Voters must be registered to vote 21 days before Election Day to vote in that election.
In 2026, those dates are:

Primary Election: Tuesday, April 28th by 11:59:59 p.m. PST

General Election: Tuesday, October 13th by 11:59:59 p.m. PST



Note: It is a felony to provide false information when registering to vote (ORS 260.715).
